## Breakfast/After School Club

We are hoping this will apply to extra-curricular clubs too.

Extra-curricular clubs are something that we pride ourselves in offering our children at St Anne's Catholic Primary School, but at the moment, we are currently only offering these clubs (outlined below) with a limit on spaces. We will continue to add to these as the weeks progress, we are currently offering:

**Wednesday:** Y4/3 – multi skills with Mr Rutter

**Thursday:** Y4 - Multi skills with Mr Rutter

**Friday:** Y3 Football with Mr Corless

Please note children attending these clubs can come to school wearing their PE kit, clubs will start just before 3pm for Lower Key Stage 2 and collection will be at 4pm at the school hall door (where our breakfast club is).

This will be the whole of Lower Key Stage 2 targeted and after half-term we will target other Key Stages. As these clubs are provided from an external source, there is a charge for them which you can pay on parent pay.

Year 2 Ladybirds - Andy Robinson, who led our summer camp has had discussions with myself and has offered to complete an extra-curricular club with Y2 on Camp Skills. The aim of this is basic skills leading up to a camp day in school in the summer term (if restrictions enable us). We will post more information on our APP to see if we have enough interest in this. If we decide to run with this club then we will move on to working with Dragonflies followed by Bumblebees.

## Remote Learning

All schools across the country have been instructed to provide remote learning in the event of a class (bubble) having to be sent home or if a child is self-isolating due to COVID-19 in their household. If this occurs, we will continue with the system that we used throughout 'Lockdown' (Seesaw) with more links to online videos and teaching through seesaw. We will endeavour to upload what takes place in class so that everyone knows what is taking place throughout the week. We will be able to provide your child/children with the learning that will take place in school. For families who do not have access to the internet or devices we will provide a work pack which will be available from school, this will include CGP books. Our curriculum will try to be the same whether in school or at home.

## Catch Up/Assessments

As mentioned above we have been so pleased at how well all our children have settled back into school life and our staff have been able to start with our curriculum making some informal assessments of our children. Next week, we will be starting formal assessments for those we feel are ready. From this we will identify any gaps that we feel may or may not be in their learning and from this analysis, we will be able to target any gaps.
