

How unpleasant were the Bronze and Iron Ages?

Vocabulary Dozen

Ard: an iron plough used in the Iron Age times,

Artefact: an object left as evidence of life in an earlier time,

Barrow Mound: a burial mound used in Bronze Age times,

Bronze: 90% copper and 10% tin,

Bronze Age: a period of history from around 2000 BCE until the start of the Iron Age around 800 BCE

Celtic: the name often given to tribes that lived in Europe and beyond the Iron Age times,

Hoard: a large collection of artefacts discovered in one place,

Hill Fort: a fortified settlement from Iron Age times,

Iron: a chemical element, hardened by the process of 'smelting',

Iron Age: a period of history from around 800 BCE until the invasion of the Romans in 43AD,

Roundhouse: a circular dwelling,

Spindles and whorls: instruments that used to make clothes.
