Weekly Update from Mr Anderson

Dear families,

We have had another wonderful week at school with so much to be thankful for. As mentioned last week, we have had the pleasure of Christine Ball from our parish (St Agnes) in school to speak to our Year 4 children as they prepare for receiving the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Fr Anton will be visiting the children next week to talk about this special Sacrament.

Easing Restrictions in school

As mentioned last week, from Monday (17th May) our different Key Stages areas will become bigger bubbles. This will enable our children to mix with each other outside. Upper Key Stage 2, Lower Key Stage 2, Key Stage 1 and our EYFS will be able to mix outside in their wider bubble (e.g. Y6, Y6/5 and Y5 will mix outside together).

Timings

On Monday 17th May we have tweaked drop off and collection times by 5 minutes. Please see page 2 of our newsletter with our changes. Please note if restrictions continue to ease nationally, we too will continue to get our school back to our normal timings.

Catch Up

Our 'Catch Up' strategy continues and we are continuing to target: reading, writing and mathematics daily using our tutors: Miss Nelson, Mr Gregson and Ms Hoefkins. Our 'Steps to Read' programme used daily in class is also part of our 'Catch Up' strategy.

Safety

Please note that our younger children should be supervised as they leave our school site and be within a 'hands reach' of the adult who is collecting them. This is so important as we do not want to see a child injure themselves on our site or outside of school. Please also be careful if you are driving to school, please park sensibly and drive safely. If you are parking nearby park in a safe place and do not obstruct local residents driveways. Please advise taxi drivers to do the same—many thanks.
