Monday 27 th September	1-2pm	3	Rhyme Time (0-1 year olds)	THIS COURSE IS AIMED AT PARENTS/ CARERS WHO HAVE CHILDREN AGED 0-1 YEAR. This Zoom course is aimed at parents/ carers of babies aged 0-1. You will be given all the resources to make props to use for Nursery Rhymes to sing with your child. We will talk about language development and why nursery rhymes are so important at this age.
Wednesday 29 th September	10-11am	3	Ready for School (Reception)	This Zoom course is aimed at parents/ carers of children who have just started Reception class. During the sessions we will look at what children need to learn, and how to teach new skills. We will also look at reading writing and maths to give you ideas of activities to do at home that will support your child's learning.
Wednesday 29 th September	1-2pm	3	Story Sacks (Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2)	You will be provided with books and resources to make all the items for your Story Sack which will be yours to keep at the end of the course. Within the Zoom group you will make the resources week to week then use them with your child at home. During the session we will discuss the benefits of sharing books and will make the various parts of your Story Sack.
Thursday 30 th September	10-11am	1	Phonics Workshop (Reception)	You will receive ideas and resources that will help you to support your child with their reading and writing in their first year of school. We will look at phonics in the Foundation Stage and how it is used to help your child learn to read and write.
Friday 1 st October	10 - 11am	3	Story Sacks (0-3 years)	THIS COURSE IS AIMED AT PARENTS/ CARERS WHO HAVE CHILDREN AGED 0-3 YEARS. You will be provided with books and resources to make all the items for your Story Sack which will be yours to keep at the end of the course. Within the Zoom group you will make the resources week to week then use them with your child at home.
