Return to School Wednesday 5th January 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy New Year to you all! I hope you have all managed some rest and recuperation during the festive break. We are looking forward to seeing everybody tomorrow and this letter is to share up to date information about our return to school after the Christmas break.

At this present moment, we are re-opening school as planned on Wednesday 5th January. As the virus is very much on the increase, I wanted to reassure you that we still have our increased measures in place and to remind you about our return. Before your child returns to school on Wednesday, if you are able to, I would encourage you to carry out a Lateral Flow Test on them. Scientists are predicting an increase in cases on the opening of schools and all that we can do to mitigate this is in everyone's interest.

We will do all that we can to stay open, but we need healthy staff to enable us to do this. Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

However, we have seen cases in school with varying symptoms, some with only a sore throat, a runny nose, a headache, fatigue or no symptoms at all. If anyone in your household is positive, your child is able to attend school as long as they have a daily negative LFT for 7 days. If your child needs to self-isolate and they are well enough to carry out home learning, our class teachers can arrange this for you. Just get in touch as soon as you can and we will do all that we can to help.

When we are aware of a positive case at school, we have to inform Knowsley Council/ Public Health England. To help us to register this as quickly as possible, please use the covid19@stannesprimaryknowsley.co.uk email and include the following:

1. Name, DOB, year group
2. Date of onset of symptoms
3. What the symptoms are
4. Whether this positive is through a LFT or a PCR and the date of each
5. Any information about siblings, ie year group




