## Extra Curricular Activities Offer

Clubs are now finished for the Summer and next year we will be continuing to offer more including extra sessions of maths and English across the school.

Many new clubs commenced this year and we hope to provide more of the same and hopefully introduce some more. This term alone we have provided: cricket, football, athletics, games, multi skills, art, performing arts and yoga. Discussions in class have taken place already with our children to get their views and opinions on clubs for next academic year.

### Good Grub Club

Good Grub Club for KS1 and KS2 will be on Thursdays next School Term, starting on Thursday 15th September. There will be a small price rise of £7.50 per session.

### Breakfast Club increase September

Since we started our breakfast club in 2007 we have never had a price increase but unfortunately due to rising food and energy costs our charges will increase to £2.50 per day (£12.50 per week) for the first child in a family. The charge for any siblings will be £2.00 per day (£10.00 per week). We will inform families when the price increase will start.

Visit the Knowsley Safari whilst the Batonbearer meets the animals in the foot safari


### Shakespeare North Playhouse: Queens Baton Relay Celebration Event 6.15-7.30pm
