

Stepped Sanctions in private

Numerous drive bys to have taken place before stepped sanctions

- 1. Reminder of rule
- 2. Warning
- 3. Last chance
 - (using microscript)
- 4. Time out
- 5. Restorative conversation

I've noticed that..... You know the school rules ready, respect, safe. Can you remember when I phoned home when you..... and how that made you feel? I expect you to..... Thank you for listening.

Restorative Questions

- 1. What has happened?
- 2. What were you thinking at the time?
- 3. Who has been affected by the actions?
- 4. How have they been affected?
- 5. What needs to be done to make things right?
- 6. How can we do things differently in the future?
