## **Covid—19 Safety Notices**

To ease congestion at the 2:40pm collection times, Lions and Tigers parents/carers can use the nursery gate and walk down the path and turn right to collect at the same gates they collect at now.

Also to ease congestion and to prevent too many adults waiting on the yard, if you have children in two different year groups you can collect your younger child at the later time. **For example:** if you have a child in Lions and Y5 you can collect you child from Lions just before 3pm and then collect your older child at 3pm. If you are waiting there is plenty of space on the yard which you can utilise.

Please also remember to leave our site promptly and to not congregate at the school gates.

## **Breakfast Club and Wrap Around Club**

Our new system is now live on the App for booking Breakfast Club and Wraparound places. Please use this facility only from now on to book a place for your child, we are no longer using the temporary email address. The system is live and places are limited; therefore it will only allow you to book a space if there are enough places left. You can book in from now up until the Christmas holidays. Please book in through the App even if you have previously booked long term places via the email address. If you book a place and no longer require it you must remember to cancel it through the App or **you will still be charged**. Breakfast Club takes place in the hall and we are based in our new nursery unit for our Wraparound club there is a direct link to phone the after school club from 3:15pm on 01514778260 and then opt for option 5 or 07388732605 if there is no answer.

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Please see below a paragraph from each key stage for forthcoming events over the Christmas period.

#### **EYFS (Bear Cubs, Lions and Tigers)**

In Early Years we have set up a wonderful stable in the outdoor classroom for the children to role play the Christmas story. We are working hard on our Nativity songs in preparation for our video recording (costumes to be in by Wednesday 9th December please) and we are all enjoying daily visits from our class elves. We are having fun playing in our cosy winter house, reading Christmas stories and writing letters and notes in preparation for Christmas. Our wrapping workshop will open next week in Reception to support the children's maths and fine motor skills. Our 'Christmas Read' will be on Thursday 10th December. This is followed by our annual Santa Dash, wearing our Christmas jumpers on Friday 11th December. EYFS Christmas dinner is on Tuesday 15th December and we will have a hot chocolate picnic with a story outside in the afternoon, so please ensure your child has a hat, scarf and gloves for this as the weather has turned particularly cold. Our Christmas parties will be on Thursday 17th December in the morning (children should come to school in their party clothes on that day) and we will watch a COVID friendly pantomime in the afternoon. We will end our very busy term with a fun morning on Friday 18th December.

## **KS1** (Bumblebees, Dragonflies and Ladybirds)

KS1 will be performing 'The Nativity' in the style of a Poem this year. Each class will perform verses of the poem and sing a Christmas Carol. This will then be turned into their very own Christmas movie.

Our budding actors will then enjoy a premiere as part of their Christmas Party before the film is sent to families via Seesaw on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December.
