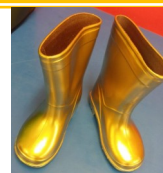

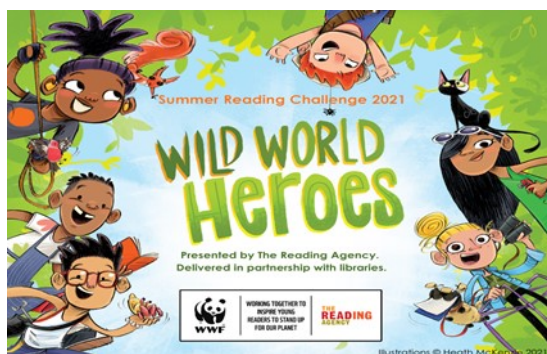

Organised by The Reading Agency and the Public library network, the Summer Reading Challenge is the UK's biggest annual reading promotion for children.

This year, they've teamed up with the World Wildlife Fund for a very special nature-themed challenge, **Wild World Heroes**, that will inspire children to take action for nature and the environment. With plenty of brilliant books to enjoy, the Challenge is the perfect summer activity to build young readers' skills and confidence during the long break from school.

Aimed at children aged 4 – 11, **Wild World Heroes** is available in all Knowsley Libraries this summer and runs from Saturday 10th July – Saturday 11th September 2021.

How the Challenge works:

- Children sign up through their local library and receive a Wild World Heroes collector poster
- Children borrow and read 6 library books of their own choice during the summer, collecting stickers and extra incentives along the way
- Children who complete the **Summer Reading Challenge** receive a certificate and a medal
