Children's University Mini Masterclass

Enrich Education and the Children's University are delighted to announce that during this January we will be hosting a virtual Children's University Mini Masterclass.

The Mini Masterclass are free, informal, fun, and engaging online lessons that children can participate in at home during the weekends.

The Mini Masterclass sessions will take place on a monthly basis throughout the year, with a different subject focus every month from Art & Crafts, History, Maths, English and many more. The sessions provide an excellent opportunity for pupils to broaden their knowledge and understanding of a variety of subjects.

January's session will focus on vocabulary, providing participants with a fun, engaging and educational session which will explore: the origin of words; how words can enter and 'fall out of' the language; the building blocks' from which many words are constructed; word 'families'; and some of the quirky and unusual words that feature in the English language. The aim of the session will be to encourage children to take an interest in words and language, to expand their vocabularies and to experiment and have fun with words.

The session will be delivered by Keith McDowall a Merseyside based school literacy consultant and former primary school teacher with decades of teaching experience.

Week commencing Monday 24th January we will be on week 1 of the school dinner menu, which can be (viewed on the app or school web site:


