Children's University - Online Mini Masterclass

Science - Plants

Enrich Education and the Children's University are delighted to announce that this April we will be hosting another of our online Children's University Mini Masterclasses.

The Mini Masterclasses are free, informal, fun, and engaging online lessons that children can participate in at home at the weekend.

The Mini Masterclass sessions will take place on a monthly basis throughout the year, with a different subject focus every month, including Art & Crafts, History, Maths, English, Science. The sessions are intended to encourage children to be curious and to awaken their interest in subjects across the curriculum.

April's subject is Science, and the masterclass will focus on plants. The session will touch on the origins of plants, how they have changed the world and the ways in which they are essential to life. It will then look at some amazing and fascinating aspects of individual plants and will finish with some suggestions for practical activities with a plant theme that children can do at home.

The session will be delivered by Keith McDowall, a former primary school teacher with decades of teaching experience.


