NEU Teacher Strike Action

As you may be aware from media coverage and our previous correspondence that the NEU (teaching union) have declared strike action, which will take place on Wednesday 1st February. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over the shortage in recruitment of teachers, better terms and conditions and funding which ultimately effects our school and children's education.

We are sorry to inform you that our school will be closed on Wednesday 1st February. We are asking you not to send your child into school on this day. School will reopen as normal on Thursday 2nd February 2023

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation and I will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further especially with the proposed up coming strike dates at the end of February and in the middle of March.
