#### Modeshift Stars

Our school has recently joined the Modeshift STARS National Accreditation Scheme and Knowsley Council STARS Scheme.

The schemes help us to look at ways to improve walking and cycling to school and consider the positive effects it has on the physical and mental health of all of our students.



We have been offered the opportunity for pupils in **Year 6** to benefit from a Bike MOT Session which will take place here at school on **Tuesday 20th June**. Students can bring their bikes into school on the day. Bikes will be checked by a specialist bike mechanic. **Pupils will not be present for the actual session**.

Minor repairs will be carried out. If any safety issues are identified which require more extensive work—an advisory note will be provided for your information and action. The mechanic will aim to work through as many bikes as possible on the day. Participants will receive a cycling related item from the team at Knowsley Council to support their cycling journeys.
