Classes for next academic year 2023/2024

As we move into July we get a lot of questions about classes and which class children will be in. Most of our families are aware that we have mixed age classes Y1/2 (Dragonflies), Y3/4 and Y5/6 in school, we would like to assure you that the children in each class are taught the same curriculum. Over the last couple of years our staff have worked extremely closely during their Planning Preparation and Assessment (PPA) time to work together to ensure consistency. Children perform equally well in mixed classes.

Children's University



Children's University is a charity that works in partnership with schools to develop a love of learning in children. They encourage and celebrate participation in extra-curricular activities in and outside of school. The impact of the children being involved in extra-curricular activities is proven to be positive which is why Children's University is committed to creating a field of opportunities and opening up access to children of all backgrounds.

If your child attends a club inside or outside of school this is a way to accumulate credits to earn Children's University awards. Any clubs that children attend outside of school must be affiliated with Children's University. This can be done on their website for any clubs wanting to get involved. We have Children's University passports available for sale at the school office to help you keep track of hours attended. During the next academic year, Miss Fraser will inform parents of days she will be collecting credits to ensure all children's credits are collected throughout the year. Dear families,

What a wonderful busy week we have had in which we had a focus on sport and refugees, as well as squeezing in assessments. We even managed our Sports Day, in which our families and school community were able to see our children take part in sporting activities. Despite the weather, we had all of our EYFS and Key Stage 1 children inside working on Sports. Thankfully the rain cleared up after lunch and we got outside for more sport with Key Stage 2.

Yesterday, we all took part in a Quidditch session and Upper Key Stage 2 continued with Gaelic football sessions - all the children had a blast!

We are hoping to add in an extra curricular session of this sport (gaelic football) in the coming Thursdays from 4pm—5pm (more information will follow). This all ties in with providing more extra curricular sessions for our children at different times after school. We received some funding for this through an application that we submitted recently and you may have noticed our new storage shed on the field which is to aid with providing storage for some new clubs. The hope is to have more girls football and community activities available for the children in the local area.

Sports

We had Y3 children visit our school from St Margaret Mary's Juniors on Tuesday for some wonderful football matches. We also had some of our Lower Key Stage 2 out taking part in an orienteering competition at Kirkby High School.
