
Consultation - Length of School Day Results

Comments

- Better for traffic
- Due to Blacklow changing to 3 o'clock collection
- Need to consider Blacklow Brow's school times with crossing over for congestion.
- Have other children to get to school
- I think to finish at 3.10pm would be better as children will be rushed during breakfast at home or in breakfast club if asked to start earlier
- Changing morning start time would be too disruptive. Assume lessons will start 10 mins after the above proposed start times as they do now
- I feel this will have the less impact on the children who have already had enough disruption
- I think starting any earlier will be problematic for many families. We travel by bus to school
 and this would massively impact this! Also families trying to get other children to nurseries
 etc. this is a particularly early time especially in the dark winter months
 No issue with the later finish time
- 3:10pm finish gives more time for the traffic to die down after Blacklow finishes at 15.00 now. It'll be safer for the children.
- When working from home, we sometimes have meetings until 3pm
- With Blacklow Brow now finishing at 1500 it'll be safer for the children to finish at 15.10 to let the pavements and road traffic die down
- Personally, neither option affects me. I have ticked the first option as I feel ten minutes split into 2 x 5 minutes might feel better for the children. However, I realise starting the day

- earlier might not appeal to a lot of parents (or children). If you feel that finishing at 3.10 pm is a significantly safer option, I think that is how it needs to be
- As far as I am aware, school starts at 8.50am not 8.40am. Finish time of 3.10pm is fine. There are no other options with this consultation. Will parents be advised of the outcome and when? School gates open at 8:40am with the children arriving into school with tasks ready to start each day. Gates close at 8:50am. Parents will be advised when this change will start which is likely to be the start of the next academic year.
- It would depend on Blacklow Brow, what time they are planning to start and finish as traffic and parking needs to be taken into consideration
- I don't feel we would stand any chance of making the start of school. As of September I will have 2 attending both with eczema which requires time of a morning. And as a local resident of the school the traffic of both schools finishing at the same time would be dangerous
- Will the children still have the same amount of breaktime and lunchtime included in this proposal? I would not support any plans to cut this shorter than it is already Of course, there will be no reduction of times at break and lunch
- Earlier as I know ... is more alert of a morning also our days start earlier due to working hours
- Most children are already at school for 8:40 anyway so not a great change yes it would be more at the end of the day an extra 10 minutes each day.
 As you have stated, much safer and less traffic finishing 10 minutes later than other schools changing their time to 3pm. We walk to school but around Marina Crescent the parking of some parents is unsafe already without further pressure of 2 schools at the same time
- Safest option for children. Some parents parking around school already dangerous without added pressure
- I am happy with either option
- It would give working parents more time to get work with an earlier start
- Earlier start would mean more parents could be at work for 9am without having to use breakfast club
- We really don't mind what time school starts or finishes. How would this affect breakfast club? – It wouldn't affect breakfast club – our plan is to review this moving forward and see if this can start a little earlier but staffing could be an issue here
- Concerned over Blacklow finishing at 3pm
- As you are a feeder primary for SFX which also finishes at 3:10, this makes simultaneous
 collection impossible valid point and we are a feeder for many other schools with various
 different start and finish times
- If the above times go ahead, I can't see it being an option to finish at 3.05 if Blacklow finish at 3pm. It would be chaos at picking up time -
- I think this is a good idea and would benefit the children
- I've chosen 8.40-3.10 due to Blacklow finishing at 3pm. However 8.35am opening would have really helped with getting to work
- The school is already congested in mornings and after school because of the two schools in close proximity and lack of parking. I think working something out that is going to be best to ease congestion as his can add 10-15 mins on to your journey time trying to find a park and having to walk etc
- I think finishing at the later time will allow traffic to die down from Blacklow
- Either option would be fine. An earlier start makes it easier for me to get to work. I think a big consideration is the timing of Blacklow Brow start and finish times as if they are too close it will cause too much traffic congestion if both schools are arriving at the same time so I think there needs to be some time between these
- Either is fine, but we have highlighted the choice that the school believe is safer

- 8.45 to 3.15 would also be helpful, to ensure the time difference is balanced between us and Blacklow Brow school
- As we live really close to the school I think this will work better for traffic with another school being so close
- As a parent travelling 10 miles to work after drop off, the earlier time works better for me.
 While I appreciate this is not schools decision, I can't see the how 10 minutes changes the
 amount of learning. Will this also affect lunch breaks? this will not have an impact on lunch
 breaks
- 5 mins makes no difference and seems a lot of fuss
- The earlier start at 8.35 may increase the amount of traffic and safety for the children due to Blacklow being in for 8.30. Our school and Blacklow should work together and discuss both schools consultation outcome to ensure a safe plan is in place to help reduce traffic in the area
- Concerns with Blacklow finishing at 3pm
- I feel there is less disruption if you are only changing one time and not both start and finish. therefore I propose keep same morning time and have a later end time
