

ST ANNE'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

To instil a sense of pride and unity at St. Anne's Catholic Primary School the following school uniform is worn:

FOUNDATION STAGE BOYS AND GIRLS: (ALL YEAR ROUND)

Red round necked sweatshirt
Red polo shirt
Red school cap
Red Book Bag
Red drawstring bag
Black jogging bottoms / leggings / shorts (no sports logos)
Black or white socks

(Please note, children may wear plain red polo shirts and sweatshirts, they do not have to have the school badge on all items)

Please note that in Foundation Stage Nursery and Reception classes the children wear a PE based uniform above all year around. Checked dresses are worn in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 in the Summer Term.

Plain black pumps / trainers (Velcro fastening)

Red fleece with school badge (our red fleece is not a replacement for a jumper or cardigan) this is in addition if this is felt what is needed

Red coat (with school badge - can be purchased from the school office)

All children should have a spare set of clothes (including underwear) in school in their drawstring bag.

All children should also have Wellington boots for outdoor play – to be left in school

KEY STAGES 1 and 2 (Years 1 to 6):

WINTER

Children should wear winter uniform of grey shorts / long grey trousers / grey skirt or pinafore (knee length) or culottes

White shirt / blouse

Red jumper / cardigan

Red and grey striped tie

Grey socks / tights

Black shoes

Red coat (with school badge - can be purchased from the school office)

Red fleece with school badge (our red fleece is not a replacement for a jumper or cardigan) this is in addition if this is felt what is needed

SUMMER

Grey shorts & white polo shirt or red / white checked dress (knee length)

Red jumper / cardigan

Grey socks with grey shorts / White socks with checked dress

Black shoes

Red coat with school badge

Red fleece with school badge (our red fleece is not a replacement for a jumper or cardigan) this is in addition if this is felt what is needed

If not purchased directly from school, coats MUST be plain RED with no fashion/sports/designer logos.

Book bags, PE bags, ties, sweatshirts and polo shirts (foundation stage only), and school caps are available for purchase from Marks & Spencer website or Lisa's Schoolwear, 275 East Prescott Road, L14 2DB, (tel no: 0151 259 8277)

School coats, waterproof jackets and fleeces are available to purchase from the school office.

P.E. KIT

Indoor - pumps, black shorts, white t-shirt / white polo shirt.

Outdoor - long sleeved red sweatshirt, white t-shirt / white polo shirt, **plain black tracksuit bottoms**, training shoes.

P.E. kits should remain in school for the whole half term. If children do not remember to bring their P.E. kit to school we have spare kits which they can use; we endeavour to ensure that no child will miss out on P.E. lessons.

Key Stage 2 classes attend swimming lessons on a rota basis.

Swimming - Trunks/costume

Towel

Swimming cap

Verruca sock as needed

ALL UNIFORM ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED

PERSONAL PROPERTY

All items of clothing and other personal property brought into school should be clearly marked with the child's name and class. For clothing sew-on printed tabs are an excellent investment.

Please note that neither the school nor the Local Authority has insurance to cover your child's property in the event of it being lost or stolen.

If parents wish their children to bring a mobile phone to school, they must sign a form to give permission for their child to have the phone in school. The phone must be labelled with the child's name and handed in at the school office every morning and collected at the end of the day.

JEWELLERY

Inexpensive watches may be worn.

In the interests of health and safety, children are not permitted to wear any jewellery in school.

Earrings are permitted but these must be small silver/brass studs with a safety back.

Extreme haircuts – hair should be neat and appropriate. Long hair should be tied back, with bobbles and ribbons in school colours. Flowers and other decorations should not be worn for school – they should be saved for 'non- uniform days'.

LOST PROPERTY

Please contact your child's class teacher in the first instance. Lost property is located in the main reception office area. Items will be kept for a term only.
