World Book Day

This year World Book Day is on Thursday 7th March 2024, it is a wonderful opportunity for us to celebrate reading across school and immerse ourselves in the texts which the children are learning about in English lessons. As a result, we ask that children come dressed relating to the book outlined below.

However, we would encourage costumes to be simple and home-made and this has been considered in these choices:

Year 6, 6/5 and 5- The Hounds of the Baskervilles (Victorians/ Sherlock Holmes)

Year 4, 4/3 and 3- The Rhythm of Rain (Blue/green theme, rainforest animals, underwater creatures.)

Ladybirds, Dragonflies and Bumblebees- Monsters and Creatures (book to be revealed) EYFS- Little Red (Fairytale character)

Breakfast Club and Wrap Around Club

As a school we are looking to reduce balances owed for Breakfast Club and Wrap Around Club. We need to ensure outstanding debt is reduced for it to be more manageable for people. As a responsible provider we have taken the decision that if balances for Wrap Around Club are over £50 in arrears and balances for Breakfast Club are over £12.50 in arrears, we will be taking away the facility to book spaces for these on the app. This will be in operation from Tuesday 6^{th} February, allowing a further weeks' notice to arrange alternative childcare should you need to.

Balances will be reviewed weekly on a Tuesday. If you are over the threshold on this day the facility will be removed until full balance has been paid. If you make payment in between and believe that the facility to book places should be reinstated, you can contact the school office and we will accommodate.

New Nursery Intake 2024—2025

For our nursery intake September 2024-2025 it is so important that your child is baptised in the catholic faith and you have evidence of this. This applies to any places becoming available before this intake. We have reviewed the closing date and applications will now close on 10th March 2024. If you have sent a form into school please ensure you have a receipt for this. Please ensure you have sent in a copy of the baptismal certificate with your application before the closing date.

Message from our Governor Margaret Woods


I am a Foundation Governor, appointed by Liverpool Archdiocese on 22 July 2022 for a 4-year term of office. I have resided in the Parish of St Agnes & St Aidan's for more than 35 years and support our Catholic community as an Extraordinary Eucharist Minister, Liturgy Reader, and Baptism Catechist.

In 2022/23 school year. I was privileged to be the Link Governor for Year 6. This academic year 2023/24, I am the Link Governor for Religious Education (RE). I visited the school in the Autumn term with a focus on the provision for the Catholic life and mission of the school, prayer and liturgy and RE.

The school has recently been inspected by the Archdiocese of Liverpool for RE. An RE Inspection is statutory for Catholic schools. They look at everything to do with the Catholic character of the school including leadership, all areas of religious education, the provision and quality of collective worship, moral and spiritual development, and links with the local Catholic community.

The Inspectors met with governors to hear how we fulfil our responsibilities as leaders of a Catholic school. They also met with the Parish Pastoral Assistant about parish-school links, including the sacramental preparation programme.
