World Book Day

This year World Book Day is on Thursday 7th March 2024, it is a wonderful opportunity for us <u>to</u> <u>celebrate reading across school</u> and immerse ourselves in the texts which the children are learning about in English lessons. As a result, we ask that children come dressed relating to the book outlined below. If your child does not wish to dress up they can attend as normal in their full school uniform.

However, we would encourage costumes to be simple and home-made and this has been considered in these choices:

Year 6, 6/5 and 5- The Hounds of the Baskervilles (Victorians/ Sherlock Holmes)

Year 4, 4/3 and 3- The Rhythm of Rain (Blue/green theme, rainforest animals, underwater creatures.)

Ladybirds, Dragonflies and Bumblebees- Monsters and Creatures (book to be revealed) EYFS- Little Red (Fairytale character)

This approach has been chosen as World Book Day is about celebrating reading and encouraging a love of reading. This simple approach also alleviates a significant cost to families.

LKS2 Library Visit

Y3, Y4/3 and Y4 will be visiting the local library to enjoy a reading session this half term. The children will enjoy this experience during the school day

Breakfast Club and Wrap Around Club

As a school we are looking to reduce balances owed for Breakfast Club and Wrap Around Club. We need to ensure outstanding debt is reduced for it to be more manageable for people. As a responsible provider we have taken the decision that if balances for Wrap Around Club are over £50 in arrears and balances for Breakfast Club are over £12.50 in arrears, we will be taking away the facility to book spaces for these on the app. This has been in operation since Tuesday 6th February.

Balances will be reviewed weekly on a Tuesday. If you are over the threshold on this day the facility will be removed until full balance has been paid. If you make payment in between and believe that the facility to book places should be reinstated, you can contact the school office and we will accommodate.

<u>Parental Feedback</u>

Bring back the music service so that children have an opportunity to learn an instrument—we have been working on this for the past two years and waiting for the music service to get back to us when more staff are in place to deliver sessions.

New Nursery Intake 2024—2025



<u>Voting</u>

Elections will be taking place in Knowsley on Thursday 2 May 2024.

This includes local elections as well as the election of the Combined Authority Mayor and the Merseyside Police and Crime Commissioner.

To vote in these elections, you must be registered to vote by 11.59pm on Tuesday 16 April 2024. If you've never registered, have moved address or changed your name, register to vote online at <u>www.gov.uk/register-to-vote</u>

Once you are registered, there are a number of different ways you can vote:-

<u>Postal vote:</u> If you are not already registered for a postal vote, you need to do so by 5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024

You can apply online for a postal vote by visiting the Government's website. You will be asked to provide your National Insurance Number.

If you are already registered for a postal vote, you don't need to do anything. You will be contacted by the Election Team when your postal vote is due for renewal.

<u>Voting by Proxy</u>: If you are unable to vote in person and would like someone to vote on your behalf, you can apply for a proxy vote. The deadline for applications is 5pm on Wednesday 17 April.

You can request a proxy vote application by contacting Knowsley's Elections Team on 0151 443 2222 or by emailing <u>elections@knowsley.gov.uk</u>

<u>Voting in person at a Polling Station:</u> If you are voting in person on Thursday 2 May, please remember to bring a valid photo ID with you. If you don't have a valid ID, you can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate up until 5pm on Wednesday 24 April. Apply online on the Government's website.
